



The City Is Excited To Announce The Upcoming Construction Of The Montage Trail And Close A Gap In City's Active Transportation Plan

Montage Trail Connection to Collier Canyon Road Project, CIP 201944 is located at the intersection of Collier Canyon Road and Las Positas College's Campus Loop Road in the City of Livermore. The Project will connect the west end of the existing Montage Trail to Collier Canyon Road and will include intersection improvements for pedestrians and bicyclists.

Purpose And Need: The Montage Trail connection is identified in the City's Active Transportation Plan and the project will close the gap in the trail system and provide connectivity and increase safety for pedestrians and bicyclists.

Scope of Work: The project consist of installation of an off-road paved asphalt concrete and on road concrete trail, sidewalk, curb and gutter, curb ramps, and will replace existing curb ramps to comply with current ADA regulations. It includes landscaping, traffic lane striping and signage, pedestrian crosswalks, buffered bike lanes, and new parking spaces on Collier Canyon Road.

Benefits To Local and Regional Communities: The project mutually benefits the City, the residents in the area and the Las Positas Community College (College) students, faculty, and staff by providing a Class I Shared Use Path for bicycling, walking, and other non-motorized uses. It will connect the west end of the existing Montage Tail to Collier Canyon Road, and create a continuous paved trail and improve safety for pedestrians and bicyclists. Since a portion of the work is on College property, the City has been working collaboratively with Chabot Las Positas Community College District and building consensus on the proposed improvements and also on acquiring a no fee trail easement. The City has also been coordinating with the Montage Homeowners Association, the residential properties located south of the trail.
