

Livermore Municipal Airport Project Aircraft Registration and Status Report Form

As stated in section 11.08.070, paragraph N, of the Airport Rules and Regulations:

Any person renting a T-hangar to store an aircraft that is not airworthy or who intends to restore, construct or engage in the major repair of an aircraft must register the project with the Airport Manager and arrange a mutually agreeable work schedule to complete the project aircraft. A periodic project status report demonstrating discernible progress pursuant to the agreed work schedule shall be filed upon request by the Airport Manager. Failure to provide evidence of discernible progress or reasonable explanation for delay will result in a 30-day notice to vacate the hangar.
