The Program

The program is only available from 8:00 pm- 7:00 am.

All participating locations have open restrooms throughout the night.

The City provides an attendant to watch over the facility and the participants.

All participants must display there placard in a visible location.

All participants must leave the parking lot by 7:00 am.

All participants must follow the program rules.



Some of the Program Rules

- 01** Display your placard on your dash or window. Make sure it is visible to the attendant.
- 02** No loud noises and/or music.
- 03** Minors and pets must be supervised by their parents or guardians at all times.
- 04** No alcohol, smoking, or drug use allowed at any of our sites.
- 05** Violent behavior of any kind (verbal and physical) towards yourself, family, participants, and CAREEvan staff will not be tolerated.
- 06** Each site might have their own additional rules. Please respect and follow those rules.

| Some Stats

- We received our first participant on June 2, 2016
- Our first year we received 9 applications. A total of 19 adults and 18 children.
- In 2017, we decided to open the program up to single individuals and couples. We had only allowed families with children in our school district the first year.

| Some Stats

- In total since the start, we have had 131 vehicles, enroll in the program. That's a total of 198 adults and 85 children.
- Currently, we have a total of 65 applicants. Placards that have a current validation date of January 1, 2019- June 1, 2019.
- 62 adults and 11 children that are currently in the program.
- This current session (January 1- Present) we are averaging between 18-22 vehicles per night. This is 28-35 individuals per night.
- We have individuals and families from all over the bay area signing up. Fremont, Dublin, Antioch, Oakland, Livermore, San Leandro, San Bruno, Stockton.
