



The complaint is generated and given a case number.



A code officer is assigned to the case.



At the expiration of the Compliance Order, the property is re-inspected.



If violation(s) are found, a *Compliance Order* is issued.



Excepting immediate public safety concerns, inspections are typically conducted w/in 2 weeks.



If the violation has not been corrected, an administrative citation; administrative hearing; or criminal action may be pursued.



Compliance is the end result which ultimately benefits the property owner(s), as well as the neighborhood.



The case is closed.

The violator and/or property owner is advised that future violation(s) may result in the immediate issuance of citations or other legal action.
