# IN THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIVERMORE, CALIFORNIA

# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT AND UPDATING EXHIBIT H OF THE THIRD AMENDED AND RESTATED AGREEMENT WITH LIVERMORE SANITATION, INC. TO INCLUDE RATE YEAR THIRTEEN RATE ADJUSTMENTS

On September 28, 2009, the Livermore City Council adopted Resolution No. 2009-189 approving a franchise agreement for solid waste collection services: *Agreement Between the City of Livermore and Livermore Sanitation, Inc. for Solid Waste, Recyclable Materials and Compostable Materials Services* (the "Original Agreement").

On May 9, 2011, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2011-069 approving the Amended and Restated Agreement between the City of Livermore and Livermore Sanitation, Inc. for Solid Waste, Recyclable Materials and Compostable Materials Services.

On September 8, 2014, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2014-141 approving the Second Amended and Restated Agreement Between the City of Livermore and Livermore Sanitation, Inc. for Solid Waste, Recyclable Materials and Compostable Materials Services.

On June 8, 2015, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2015-075 approving the Special Rate Review Amendment to the Franchise Agreement.

On November 9, 2015, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2015-157 approving the Second Amendment to the Franchise Agreement.

On April 27, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-051 approving the *Third Amended and Restated Agreement Between the City of Livermore and Livermore Sanitation, Inc. for Solid Waste, Recyclable Materials and Compostable Materials Services* (the "Franchise Agreement").

For the rate period commencing July 1, 2022, the Franchise Agreement allows Livermore Sanitation, Inc. to adjust its rates using an index-based methodology. The index-based methodology utilizes various cost adjustment factors such as the percentage change in the consumer price index and the percentage change in the tipping fees. The City's role in approving an index-based rate increase is to determine whether the requested rate adjustment is consistent with the methodology.

City staff reviewed the requested rate adjustments to be effective July 1, 2022, and determined that they comply with the rate methodology in the Franchise Agreement, and staff therefore recommended its approval by the City Council.

Following the public hearing and review, the City Council agreed to the recommended rate structure and services provided in connection therewith and associated amendments to the Franchise Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Livermore, as follows:

- 1. The City Council hereby finds that the index-based rate adjustment is consistent with the methodology in the Franchise Agreement, and therefore approves, effective July 1, 2022, the Solid Waste, Recyclable Materials, and Compostable Materials Service rates as set forth in the revised Exhibit H which, is attached as Exhibit A to this resolution, and is incorporated for all purposes into the Franchise Agreement.
- 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to sign on behalf of the City of Livermore the First Amendment to the Franchise Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit B. A copy of the original agreement, and all subsequent amendments thereto, are on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
- The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this resolution, including approving minor changes to the proposed amendment.

#### **RECITALS**

On April 27, 2020, City and Contractor entered into that certain Third Amended and Restated Agreement for Solid Waste, Recyclable Materials, and Compostable Materials Services ("Original Agreement"). Article 13, section 13.5 of the Original Agreement requires that any modifications to it must be in writing and signed by the parties.

City and Contractor desire to amend the Original Agreement to fund additional contributions to the rate reserve account described by Article 8, section 8.2 of the Original Agreement. This Amendment is the first amendment to the Original Agreement.

#### **AGREEMENT**

**NOW, THEREFORE,** City and Contractor hereby agree that the aforementioned recitals are true and correct and further agree as follows:

The Original Agreement is amended as follows:

Article 8, section 8.2 B of the Original Agreement is amended to read as follows:

B. Rates for Rate Period Eleven and Twelve. Rates for Rate Periods Eleven and Twelve were determined by Contractor and City Contract Manager and were approved by City Council resolution at the time of the execution of this Agreement and are reflected in Exhibit H to the Agreement. The Rates for Rate Period Eleven are effective January 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021. The Rates for Rate Period Twelve are effective July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. Rates for Rate Periods Eleven and Twelve shall not be adjusted to reflect either increases or decreases in costs from those anticipated by Contractor; provided, however, that if any adjustments for Rate Period Eleven or Rate Period Twelve are warranted under Section 8.4 or 8.5, such adjustments will be made retroactively in Rate Period Thirteen. Rates for Rate Periods 13 and beyond shall be determined in accordance with Section 8.3 and, to the extent applicable, Sections 8.4 and 8.5.

As an inducement to enter this Agreement, Contractor offered City to have no rate adjustment from Rate Period Ten to Rate Periods Eleven and Twelve. Rather than have no increase and then a disproportionately high increase to rates in Rate Period Thirteen, the City and Contractor agreed to a rate increase in Rate Periods Eleven and Twelve with the difference between the approved increase and the no increase alternative offered by Contractor contributed to a rate reserve fund retained by the

Contractor (the "rate reserve"), until such funds were earned by the Contractor through a lesser increase to rates calculated in accordance with this Agreement or through the Contractor's incurring costs for services and programs not contemplated in this Agreement and not otherwise provided for in this Agreement.

In order to determine the difference between the approved increase and the no increase alternative offered by Contractor, at the time rates are determined, Contractor will provide a projection, with supporting information, of Gross Rate Revenues (with and without the approved rate increase). For example, if the Gross Rate Revenues in Rate Period 11 without a rate increase were projected to be \$28,000,000, and the approved rate increase were 2.0%, then the projected Gross Rate Revenues would be \$28,560,000 and the anticipated deposit to the rate reserve would be \$560,000 which equals 1.96% (\$560,000/28,560,000).

At the end of Rate Periods 11 and 12, Contractor shall provide a report of Actual Gross Rate Revenues. For example, if at the end of Rate Period 11 the Gross Rate Revenues were \$28,750,000, then the Gross Rate Revenue would be multiplied by the 1.96% resulting in \$563,500 being contributed to the rate reserve. Alternatively, should the Rate Period 11 Gross Rate Revenues be \$28,250,000, then this amount would be multiplied by the 1.96% resulting in \$553,700 being contributed to the rate reserve.

Starting in Rate Period 13 at the City's discretion, the Contractor may be compensated from the rate reserve for any rate adjustment less than that calculated in accordance with the annual adjustment process or under Sections 8.4 or 8.5. For example, if the rate reserve is used to offset a rate increase in Rate Period 13 the rate adjustment process resulted in a revenue requirement of \$29,000,000 corresponding to a rate increase of 3.5% (\$1,015,000), and the approved rate increase were 2.0% (corresponding to \$580,000), then the difference of \$435,000 1.50% (\$435,000/\$29,000,000) would be contributed from the rate reserve. If at the end of Rate Period 13 the Gross Rate Revenues were \$29,500,000, it would be multiplied by the 1.50% resulting in \$442,500 being earned by the Contractor and subtracted from the rate reserve. Alternatively, should the Rate Period 13 Gross Rate Revenues be \$28,540,000, then this amount would be multiplied by the 1.5% resulting in \$428,100 being subtracted from the rate reserve. The Parties agree that the rate reserve funds will be used by the end of the initial term of the Agreement, before the end of Rate Period 20 on June 30, 2030.

Rates for Rate Period Thirteen. The Rates for Rate Period Thirteen (13) are effective July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. Rates for Rate Periods 14 and beyond shall be determined in accordance with Section 8.3 and, to the extent applicable, Sections 8.4 and 8.5.

Contractor submitted the required rate adjustment application indicating a baseline Rate increase of 0.58% is necessary.

For Rate Period 13, the City did not opt to compensate the Contractor from the rate reserve fund. Instead, rather than have a small increase and then a disproportionately high increase to rates in Rate Period Fourteen and beyond due to anticipated future costs related to inflation, labor, and new state regulation, the City and Contractor agreed to an additional 1.42% rate increase in Rate Period Thirteen, for a total increase of 2%.

The revenue generated by the difference between the approved 0.58% increase and the 2% increase will be contributed to a rate reserve fund retained by the Contractor (the "rate reserve"), until such funds were earned by the Contractor through a lesser increase to rates calculated in accordance with this Agreement or through the Contractor's incurring costs for services and programs not contemplated in this Agreement and not otherwise provided for in this Agreement.

In order to determine the difference between the additional 1.42% increase and the 0.58% increase, at the time rates are determined, Contractor will provide a projection, with supporting information, of Gross Rate Revenues (with and without the additional 1.42% rate increase).

At the end of Rate Period 13, Contractor shall provide a report of Actual Gross Rate Revenues. For example, if the Gross Rate Revenues in Rate Period 13 without a rate increase were projected to be \$30,000,000, and the additional rate increase is 1.42%, then the projected Gross Rate Revenues would be \$30,426,000 and the anticipated deposit to the rate reserve would be \$426,000 which equals 1.42% (\$426,000/\$30,426,000).

Starting in Rate Period 14 at the City's discretion, the Contractor may be compensated from the rate reserve for any rate adjustment less than that calculated in accordance with the annual adjustment process or under Sections 8.4 or 8.5. The Parties agree that the rate reserve funds will be used by the end of the initial term of the Agreement, before the end of Rate Period 20 on June 30, 2030.

- 2. These amendments are prospective and only apply to the Services rendered by Contractor after the execution of this Amendment. Unless otherwise stated herein, this Amendment does not relieve the parties of the terms and conditions of the Original Agreement as written and in effect at the time the Services were rendered.
- Except as amended above, the Original Agreement remains in full force and effect.
